RAMIFICATIONS OF FAILED PRETREATMENT

- CLOGGING REDUCES INFILTRATION CAPACITY
- DEBRIS BUILD UP IN CURBCUT CAN CAUSE BYPASS BEFORE THE GARDEN IS FULL
- SEDIMENT IN GARDEN IS UNSIGHTLY AND SMOTHERS PLANTS

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COMMON PRETREATMENT PROBLEMS

TURF FILTER STRIPS ARE OFTEN INEFFECTIVE, REQUIRING EXHAUSTIVE RAKING AND ANNUAL SOD REPLACEMENT.



ROCK INLET EFFECTIVENESS DIMIN-ISHES RAPIDLY WITHOUT FREQUENT LABOR INTENSIVE CLEANING.




